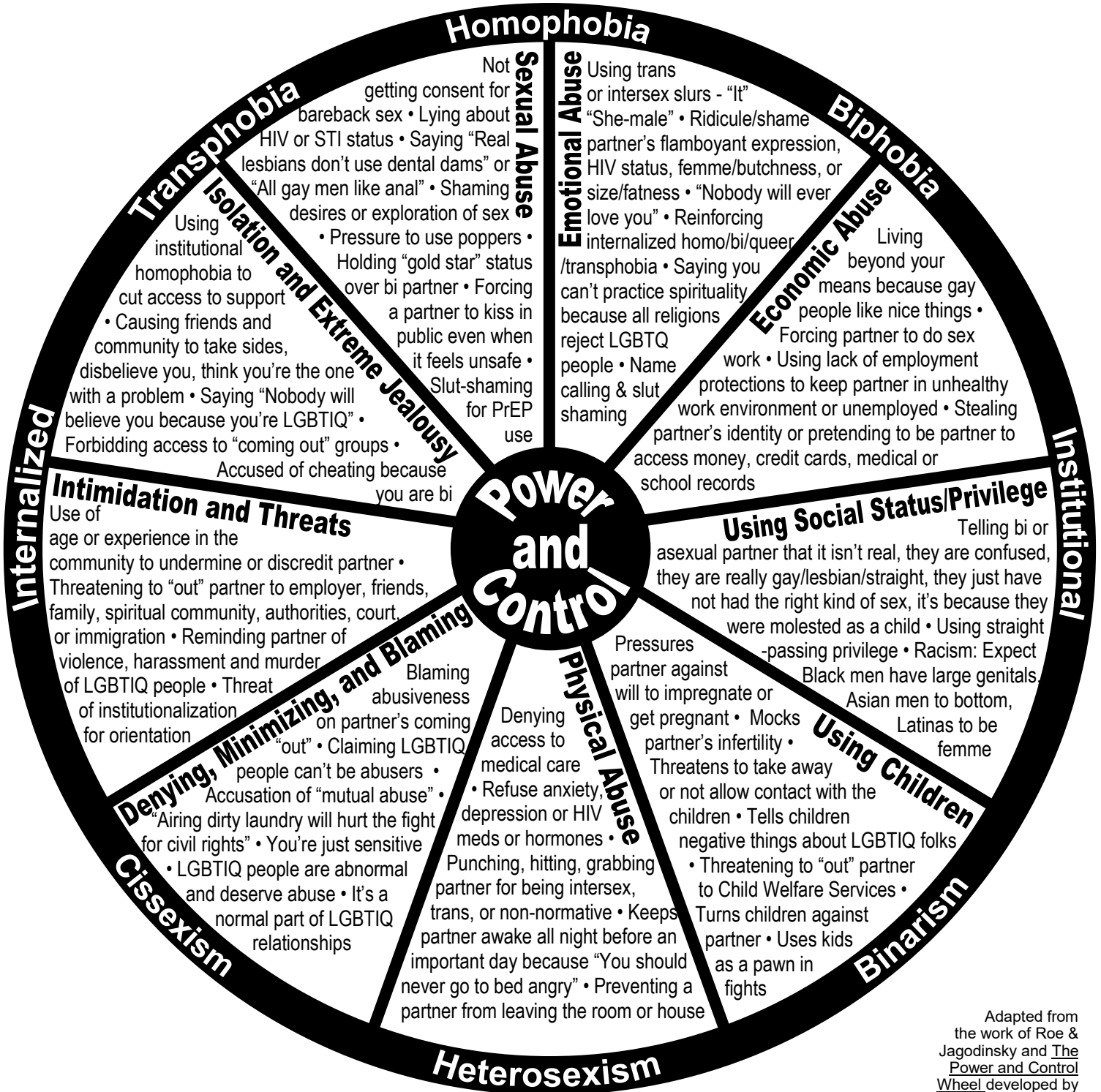


Partner Abuse in LGBTIQ Relationships

A deliberate pattern of assaultive and manipulative behaviors done by one partner (or ex partner) to gain power and control over the thoughts, feelings, or actions of another partner. Partners may be married, dating, seeing each other, hooking up, or broken up.
